

Visa for EU Blue Card (Section 18g Residence Act) without family

Online visa application for Blue Card (EU) for qualified academic professionals

You want to submit an application for a Blue Card (EU) and do not have family members, who want to move with you to Germany? In this case you can apply for the visa online via the Consular Services Portal of the Federal Foreign Office. After you have uploaded the application form and the necessary documents, your documents will be checked in advance to ensure they are complete and questions can be clarified via the portal before the actual appointment at the embassy. During the appointment at the embassy, only your identity will be verified, you will have to submit your biometric data (fingerprints and photo) and the fee will have to be paid.
